## Notice of Cooperative Agreement Fiscal Year 2012 Securing the Cities Program

Pursuant to Section 507 of the *Fiscal Year (FY) 2012 Department of Homeland Security Appropriations Act* (P.L. 112-74), the Department is notifying the Committees on Appropriations that the following cooperative agreement award will be issued under the FY 2012 Securing the Cities (STC) Initiative on or about October 15, 2012:

\$1,500,000 Los Angeles Mayor's Office, Los Angeles/Long Beach Urban Areas Security Initiative area

P.L. 112-74 provides \$37 million to the Domestic Nuclear Detection Office for System Acquisition funds. The referenced cooperative agreement award will be allocated from these funds.

This is the first award to the Los Angeles Mayor's Office and the participating regional partners to design and implement or enhance existing architectures for coordinated and integrated detection and interdiction of nuclear materials that are out of regulatory control and that may be used as a weapon within high-threat, high-density urban areas.
